Prince Albert Model Forest Community Funding for Projects Promoting Healthy Forests

Prince Albert, December 20, 2004 -

The Prince Albert Model Forest is offering funding to communities interested in initiating projects that promote healthy forests. Whether located within the 367,000 hectare Model Forest area, or beyond the boundaries, any community is eligible to apply.

Your community may be interested in projects as varied as developing a trail through the forest, conducting a river clean-up, creating an interpretive learning centre or brochure, developing a community fuel break, exploring non-timber forest products, or expanding research that furthers our understanding of sustainable forest management.

The deadline for project submissions is March 1st, 2005. Projects that promote partnerships and can provide half of their funding will be given preference.

The Prince Albert Model Forest is about more than just forestry. It's about gathering and sharing traditional ecological knowledge. It's about educating each other about our forests and their inhabitants. It's about managing our wildlife populations in order to provide for traditional lifestyles. It is research that improves our knowledge of forest ecosystems and our management of these vital resources. It is a partnership of governments, industry, Aboriginal organizations, and communities committed to meeting the needs of current generations while ensuring healthy forests for the future.
